Mission

The Air Cargo Association of Hawaii (ACAH) offers this Scholarship Program to provide an opportunity for higher/continuing education among its member's children in Hawaii.

Scholarship

ACAH is proud to offer its member's children, who are attending high school in Hawaii and are in their senior year of High School (see note at bottom), a scholarship opportunity to assist with continuing their education at a university/college, community college or trade school.

Through our scholarship program, we help motivate and inspire students to graduate and continue on to a university/college, community college or a trade school.

Scholarship Details

Students in their senior year of High School are required to fill out our application and meet all qualifications in order to be considered.

If required, students may be called to participate in a person-to-person interview.

In order to receive the university/college, community college or trade school scholarship, students must successfully complete the 12th grade of high school in Hawaii and meet all graduation requirements.

Proof of accepted to an accredited university/college, community college or trade school is required prior to being awarded the scholarship money.

The scholarship can range from \$500 to \$1000 depending on available funds from our scholarship fundraisers, primarily our Annual Scholarship Golf Tournament.

The number of scholarships to be awarded depends on the number of qualifying applicants and funds available.

*(Note: Accredited Home School is eligible, subject to ACAH Board Review)

ACAH Scholarship Program 2020 - continued

Requirements

Applicant must be the child or dependent of a participating Air Cargo Association of Hawaii (ACAH) valid paid member.

Applicant must be in their 12th year of high school (Senior) in Hawaii at time of application.

Complete the ACAH Scholarship Application.

Show proof of continuing education to a University/College, Community College or trade School.

Provide answers as listed on the application on a separate sheet:

- List High school activities
- High School Honors
- Community activities and Services and Organizations
- Name the University/College, Community College or Trade School
- Provide two letters recommendations from a teacher, coach or mentor.
- Submit a word essay describing the applicants Career Goals. (300 word minimum)
The essay may be used to help select between applicants should there be a tie.

Students **must** graduate High School. Proof of graduation is required.

ACAH requires students under the age of 18 to obtain parental permission in order to be considered for a scholarship. Parents must sign the application.

Questions and Answers

How many scholarships are awarded each year?

The number of scholarships awarded each year may vary, depending on funds. A maximum of five may be issued.

How are scholarship recipients chosen?

Because of the large number of applicants, not everyone who applies will receive a scholarship. The final decisions are made by the ACAH Board of Directors and are based on the student's application, essay, references, and possible personal interview.

Who receives the money from the scholarships?

Funds awarded are paid directly to the applicant or parents.

Can a student receive more than one scholarship?

No - Students are only eligible to receive one scholarship from ACAH.

Submit application

Applications are accepted from February 3 thru May 1, 2020

Deadline: May 1, 2020

Notification

Scholarship winners will be notified between May 18 – June 12, 2020

Additional Requirements

If you are selected as a recipient, you will be invited to a luncheon on Tuesday, July 14, 2020 to receive your scholarship check and meet the members of the Air Cargo Association.

Further, we request a photo of the recipient to be used in our Air Cargo Day program and on our web site to promote this scholarship. By submission of the application, recipient agrees to the use of photo in publication to announce award and promote this scholarship program. 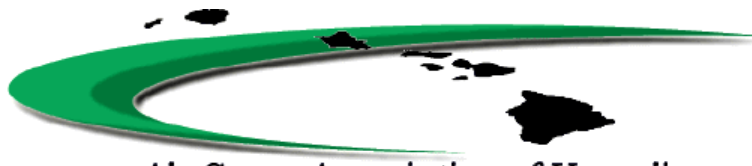
